# For Android Devices Translate websites

The Translate Android app doesn't support website translation. To translate websites on your Android device, you can use:

- Google Translate on your mobile browser
- Chrome Android app

To translate entire documents, you can:

#### Iphone & Ipad Translate websites

The Translate iOS app doesn't support website translation. To translate websites, you can use:

- Google Translate on your mobile browser
- Chrome iOS app

#### **Translate documents**

To translate entire documents, you can:

- Copy and paste the text into the Translate app
- Use Google Translate on your browser
  - Document translation is only supported on medium to large screens, like iPads or larger.

# Translate websites on Computer with Google

- 1. In your browser, go to **Google Translate**.
- 2. Choose the languages to translate to and from.
  - To automatically set the original language of a website, click **Detect language**.
- 3. In the text box, enter a URL.
- 4. Click the URL that appears. This opens a new tab with the translated website.
