

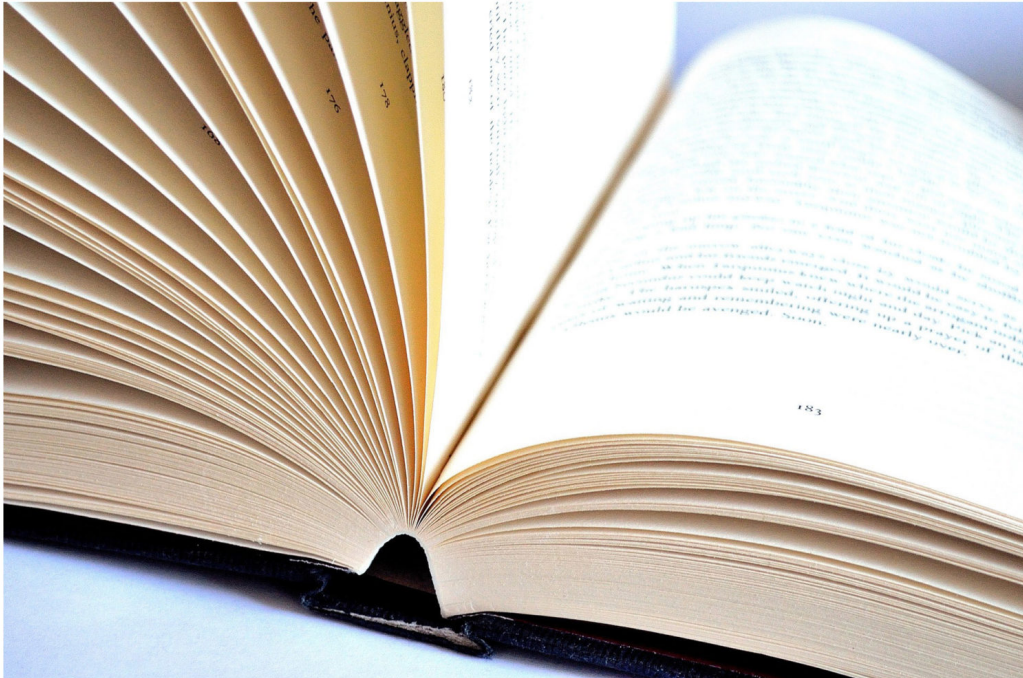


# The Plan of Recovery Big Book Workshop

**Answering Hotline calls** – many calls are from people simply looking for information about AA and local meetings and we provide it to those callers.

**12th Step calls** – for those callers who are asking for help for themselves. Our volunteer AAs telephone the person who has asked for help. What begins with a simple phone call can result in a person attending their first AA meeting.

**Transportation to a meeting** – for callers who desperately want to go to an in-person meeting but lack transportation. Many AAs from throughout the Lehigh Valley extend themselves to fellow alcoholics with this very generous type of service.
