Translate documents

To translate entire documents, you can:

NOTE: Document translation is only supported on medium to large screens, like iPads or larger.

To Translate on a Windows computer using the MS Edge browser:

1. Go to Settings and more > Settings .
2. Select Languages from the Settings list.

Translate websites on a Windows Computer with Google

1. In your browser, go to [Google Translate](#).
2. Choose the languages to translate to and from.

NOTE: To automatically set the original language of a website, click **Detect language**.

3. In the text box, enter a URL.
4. Click the URL that appears. This opens a new tab with the translated website.
