Step 9. - Made direct amends to such people, wherever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others. We should waste no time beginning the actual amend making. We can begin immediately making amends to our loved ones who have most been affected by our insanities, our self-serving unlovingness, our fears and resentments. Although one purpose of doing the 9th step is to bring our lives to order, our REAL purpose is to FIT OURSELVES to be of MAXIMUM service to God and the people about us, setting all past relationships right, and establishing new ones on that solid bedrock.

Tradition 9: Our groups ought never be organized; but we may create service boards or committees directly responsible to those they serve.

In the real world businesses and other groups are "organized." There is a hierarchy of authority established so that some members of the organization have the authority to "direct" the actions of others. But in 12 step rooms, no one has this kind of authority. The groups are a "fellowship of equals." Decisions are made by the group as a whole and not by one or a few members.

Concept IX:

Short Form: Good service leadership at all levels is indispensable for our future functioning and safety. Primary world service leadership, once exercised by the founders, must necessarily be assumed by the trustees.

Directions from Route 12:

Take 422W/Warren St Bypass to Paper Mill Road exit. At the end of the ramp, continue straight. At the next light (Berkshire Blvd) turn right. Take this until the road ends. Turn left onto Tulpehocken Road. Go approximately 1.5 miles and the Red Bridge Recreation Area entrance will be on the right (if you get to the Red Covered Bridge, you have gone too far.)

From Route 222.

Take Broadcasting Road exit. Follow signs for Penn State Berks Campus, you will come to a stop sign (3 way intersection) at the bottom of Broadcasting Road. Turn left at stop sign onto Tulpehocken Road. The park entrance is approximately .5 mile on the right (if you get to the Red Covered Bridge, you have gone too far.)

Member's Corner:

When I got sober my sponsor made it very clear how imperative it was for me to place myself in a position to be of service to my fellow alcoholics. So at a year sober I joined the hotline. I have been a part of the hotline for almost six years now. I was reflecting back over the last year and the half a dozen or so calls I have received from people calling in for help. I just recently got a call from a guy who had some sobriety and slipped away from the program. He basically told me he could not go another day and he wanted help. I asked him if he wanted to go to a meeting or the detox. His reply was he didn't want to show up at a meeting drunk and the last time he showed up at the rehab they would not let him in. So I had a friend of my call the local rehab while I stayed on the line with this guy. It turned out the rehab had a bed and they new the guy and welcomed him to come over. Once I relayed this message to the guy he said to come and get him. So me and my buddy Charlie jumped in the car to get this guy the help he needed. When we picked this guy up he looked at me and Charlie and said no one had ever gone out of there way to help him like this. I looked at him and said this is what we do. We stayed with him at the rehab for a bit of time. We also passed along our names and numbers so he has some connections when he gets out. On the ride home all we could talk about is how good it feels to be able to help today instead of being a hindrance. I don't know if the man we dropped off at the rehab will get sober or stay sober but I do know this, I know Charlie and I stayed sober that night as a result of taking action and being of service when someone had the courage to reach out and ask for help. Thanks AA for teaching me another way to live.
