- 1. Attended NERAASA in Hershey 1315 attendees. Conference for the NE region of AA (Maryland, Delaware, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York, Connecticut, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, Maine, New Hampshire, and Vermont which includes 18 areas (we are Area 59); 13,000 groups; 340,000 members
- 2. District officers at large will be giving a more comprehensive overview of the conference.
- 3. I attended and represented Reading Berks Intergroup for 2 sessions at around table discussion.
- 4. Topics discussed were:
- > how to reach "dark" groups (groups that do not send an IGR)
- > cost and efficiency of our hotlines
- > how to determine if only eligible voters are voting on motions on the floor
- > having a "share" day with our districts to work together and minimize redundancy in our service efforts (PCP/PI, Bridging the Gap, Corrections, etc)
- > methods and equipment to have hybrid intergroup meetings
- 5. Ideas for "fun-raisers" and Unity: gratitude dinner or serenity breakfast with silent auction, workshops, Bingo, Old Timer Speaker Event, Burn Your Resentments Bonfire, Fourth of July Fireworks, Sobriety Skit/puppet show, Sober Splash (ocean, pool party, lake, etc), trip to GSO or Founders Day, dance or Gala with local art and artisan silent auction.
- 6. Have an RBI YPAA liaison (Young People's AA)
- 7. I just got home 2 days ago, and I will be considering these ideas and how they may impact us going forward. More will be revealed.
